'97 I leave my everlasting friendship and the ability to reach your goals. To anyone I left out then sorry! I'm out of here.












Homecoming Week started with: Monday - Pajama Day Tuesday - Backwards Day Wednesday - Camouflage Day Thursday - Maroon and White
