

EPAL makes more than 30,000 home connections in the outskirts of Luanda

The Public Water Company (EPAL) has carried out, in the last eight days, the symbolic act of delivering more than 31 thousand home connections, in several districts of the municipality of Belas, benefiting about 200 thousand families.



Speaking to Angop today, Epal spokesman Domingos Paciência said that the project is part of the 700,000 connections and covered the districts of Chimbicato, Guerrilheiro, Bondo Chapé, Maria Eugenia, August 28, Soba Kpaça and Alegria .

At the time, the official said that last week in the context of the same project , it was given as finished the launch of a 400 mm conduit that connects the region of the Engineering Laboratory to Avenida 21 de Janeiro, in the urban district of Maianga.

"At this point, the conduct this testing phase and in the near future will benefit the neighborhoods of Paviterra, Rocha Pinto, Morro bento Gamek left and right and of Paiol, also in Maianga," he said.

The 700 thousand connections project , is an initiative of the Angolan Executive with the purpose of increasing the distribution of water, with the construction of new networks and realization of domiciliary connections in the peripheral zones of Luanda.
