**BURNING OF LEAVES, TRASH
AMENDMENT I
VILLAGE OF ELKTON, MICHIGAN
Ord. No. 47 eff. 8-22, 1983**

An Ordinance to amend the Village Ordinance Code by amending Ordinance No. 47, Section 20.761 pertaining to the burning of leaves, or trash within the Village of Elkton.

THE VILLAGE OF ELKTON ORDAINS:

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 20.761

20.761 (a) Sec. 1. Burning in Streets, Alleys' Unlawful.

Section 20.761 of Ordinance No. 47, Village of Elkton, Michigan is hereby amended as follows:

Section 20.761: It shall be unlawful to burn leaves, lumber, trash or any other combustible material whatsoever in any street or alley in the Village of Elkton, including shoulders of the streets; and it shall be unlawful to burn leaves, lumber, trash or any other combustible material whatsoever in any barrel or fire container unless said barrel and fire container is located at the rear portion of said property where the burning occurs.

This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the date of its adoption.
