This week, we would really like the children in Year 3 to keep practising their times tables on TTRS and to read as many books as possible on Bug Club.

Alongside this, please complete the commas in a list homework; for some of you, this will be pages 46-47 of your English homework book and for others, pages 14-15.

For maths homework, please complete the fractions work in your Maths homework books - for some of you, this will be pages 32-33 (adding fractions) and others, it will be page 17.

If you would like any extra homework (and we appreciate that for many parents who are working from home, this may be very tricky to accommodate), please practise telling the time on both digital and analogue clocks:

AM/PM

O'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to  
an hour before/after a given time

leading to:

half an hour before/after a given time

minutes past/to the hour (e.g. 17 minutes past 5, 26 minutes to 10)

Finally, we have been studying the Stone Age so if the children would like to research any aspect of the Stone Age (hunting/gathering, homes, tools, food, homes etc) and make a fact file about it, that would be brilliant!
