

# **ANDREW KRZESZEWSKI**

## **1901 - 1993**

Andrew Krzeszewski (Miller), 91, lifelong Kinde and Dwight Township resident, passed away Tuesday, Jan. 12 at the Huron County Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe after a long illness.

He was born Dec. 4, 1901 in Dwight Township, near Kinde, son of the late Mike and Katherine (Navock) Krzeszewski. He married Regina Leavine on Nov. 17, 1931 at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Port Austin. She preceded him in death on Jan. 11, 1945.
