# NOTES FROM THE NURSE

ADDICTIVE DRUGS

Dale's definition of an addictive drug; a dangerous, mind altering, inhabition lowering, addictive substance. This applies to alcohol, the opiates, and marijuana.

It seems inconsistent to me that the country is alarmed about the "opiate overdose crisis" and our state is considering making marijuana a legal recreational drug.

God gave us pain relieving drugs for that purpose. They do that! When they are used to get high we are misusing them.

In my experience working with addicts, I've found that it seems that the first high is so great that we try to repeat that and it takes more and more to reach that great feeling. That's how we become addicted and the potential for overdose begins. The only way to avoid overdose is to NOT USE THE DRUG!!

Here are some of the unwanted results to consider with extended use of marijuana: 1. Killed brain cells, especially in developing brains(you can't grow them back. All "dead heads" aren't in musical groups) 2. becoming addicted and progressing to more powerful drugs. 3. Potential for addicted babies at birth. 4. Possible altering of stored eggs in females, resulting in Atoma - Latin for Indivisible, Atomic, that which cannot be cut. Atoma - "Annunciation" for Youth Group! Atoma - Mission - to provide a safe and fun space for our youth; to interact & socialize with one another, to develop friendships with peers who are being raised with a common set of values, and to comfortably comment on their faith & its role in their daily lives.


