B. It is pronounced õ**Yeshua**.ö It is the actual name of õ**Jesus**ö who was born about 6 BCE and crucified by the Roman army about 27 CE. Our focus is on the õ**Yeshua of History**,ö not the õ**Jesus of Conflicting Theologies**.ö
