Instructions

- 1. Check the piece over for blemishes and wipe back with paper towel.
- 2. Using provided Pattern, Red Pencil and Clay Carbon transfer the design onto plate.
- 3. Damp sponge the ware to remove any dust and to condition the piece for decorating.
- 4. Complete the design as follows blocking in three coats of each color as smoothly as possible. Be neat and use the #10 Shader and the various Rounds requested. Complete the design area first and then proceed last with the background.
 - a. Wineglass Really White
 - b. Wine Dark Wine
 - c. Opening of Cheese Bright Saffron
 - d. Wax on Cheese Really Red
 - e. Wine Bottle Bright Kelp
 - f. Label on Wine Bottle Bright Aqua
 - g. Grapes Light Grape
- 5. Shade as follows with #10 Shader fully water dampened and corner loaded with:
 - a. Light Aqua for the wineglass.
 - b. Neon Orange for the cheese opening
 - c. A mix of **Really Red** and a hint of **Dark Black** for shading on the wax of the cheese.
 - d. If desired shade the edge of wine bottle with Bright Kelp and a hint of Dark Black.
- 6. Shade the grapes using the small Round or the #4 Shader using:
 - a. Dark Wine
 - b. Really Red
 - c. Bright Grape
 - d. Dark Grape
 - e. Dark Purple

Be sure to follow the contour of the grapes when shading and highlighting is applied.

- 7. Using the #6 Round and Glaze Fan apply three very smooth coats of **Ginger Sprinkles** to the background and back side of the ware. Be neat with the application.
- 8. Allow the **Ginger Sprinkles** some time to dry.
- 9. Thin **Dark Black** with water or Thin 'n Shade to light cream consistency. Fully load #1 Liner with thinned **Dark Black**. Proceed to detail the entire design and be sure to sign the piece.
- 10. Allow to dry 24-hours.
- 11. Smoothly apply one coat of **Pure Brilliance** to entire piece. Allow to dry before firing.
- 12. Stilt ware and fire to shelf cone 06.
- 13. Remove stilt marks with stilt stone or Dremel tool.
