Update: The proposed draft of the City of San Antonio Electrical Code (Chapter 10) was approved by the City Council on January 15 and will become effective on April 1. In all, the 2008 NEC will be used, upcoming or new maintenance personnel that repair electrical items as indicated in Chapter 10 will require an approved eight-hour course as a prerequisite for the Electrical Maintenance Technician Registration (EMT), and there are "no continuing education requirements" for an existing EMT. However, continuing education requirements for the Maintenance Electrician (ME) remain the same.

The San Antonio City Council has not approved CPS's budget to date—this includes any rebates. At best, it may be a month or two before the rebates (if any) are approved! 

January Lunch Summary by Robert Andrews, Jr.

One hundred and fourteen members attended the January SAABE meeting sponsored by Voss Lighting!

Bryan Lesch from Phillips Lighting provided many surprising statistics about US lighting needs. As a country, we use the most electricity in the world. Twenty-four percent of the world's energy is used here, and 22% of that is for lighting. The second largest user of electricity for lighting is China at 10%. On average, the lighting of a commercial building uses 51% of the total power used to operate the building. Brian broke it down further into 42% for incandescent, 41% florescent, and 10% in HID. Eighty percent of buildings in the country are still using pre-1986 lighting, and, on average, retrofitting one of these buildings will have a payback of two to three years.

To help educate people, Phillips has developed their own version of the three Rs. The first is to reduce the amount of waste, energy and toxic materials. A great way to reduce the amount of waste is by moving up to a long-life bulb. Phillips has introduced their new brand of T8 bulbs, the Alto II. These bulbs contain 1.7mg of mercury. This is by far the lowest amount of mercury compared to any other bulb. This means that the Alto II bulbs are not only better for the environment, but, with the new technology, will help to reduce operating costs. By using the extra long life version of the Alto II, there is 67% longer life, so less labor costs in re-lamping and

less money spent on recycling. Phillips believes so strongly in their new bulbs, that a warranty period of up to 48 months comes on every bulb.

The second is to reuse the packaging and materials. Phillips does this by reusing all of the mercury in its bulbs.

The last R is for <u>recycle</u>. It is already a mandate that users producing more than 1kg per month of acutely hazardous waste on their property must recycle their lights. There are a couple of different options to recycle bulbs. The easiest is to ship them off to be recycled. All that is required is to purchase the shipping box, and, as you replace the lights, you put the old bulbs in the box and Fed/ Ex them off to the recycling facility.

- 3) To work with engineers who have begun the Energy Star program or the LEED O/M (operation and maintenance) or E/B (existing buildings) programs for assistance in, education with, and encouragement with their completion.
- 4) To cooperate and work in concert with the SABOMA Green Committee to meet the 7 Point Challenge given by BOMA International with the first point a 30% reduction in energy consumption by 2010.

THE PLAN

- 1) Newsletter articles on areas of interest expressed to the Going Green Group.
- 2) Seminars to update and educate SAABE Engineers on current issues and topics.
- 3) Survey the SAABE membership for energy saving upgrades, lighting retrofits, water conservation programs, and other programs reducing energy consumption.


