

ORDINANCE NO 785 .

An Ordinance in relation to extending sidewalks and front walks from the North side ^{and west} of Block Fifty-five (55) ^{and Oak street respectively}, to curb and gutter on the paved street of Fifth (5) Avenue, in the City of Garnett, Kansas.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and ^{Board of} Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas.

^{and west} on the North side of Block 55. in the city of Garnett, Ka
Section 1. That the sidewalk shall be extended to the curb of the paved street as near as may be ^{and} on a level with the top of the curb, and ~~Section 2.~~ That said sidewalk extending to the curb in said street shall not be built against the curb, but a space of not less than one-half inch left between the edge of said sidewalk and the said curb, which space shall be filled with sifted sand or Asphaltum.

Section 2. That the extention of the sidewalk mentioned in Section 1. of this ordinance shall be constructed by the property owners abutting thereon within Thirty Days from the taking effect of this Ordinance and if not so constructed then the same shall be constructed by the city and the costs thereof assessed against the abutting proprty owners according to the front foot thereof, and collected as other taxes.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be inforce from and after Ten days ^{after} its passage, and ^{its} publication in the Garnett Review in said City.
