WHEREAS, the Governing Board desires to regulate the access and provision of public records to members of the public as required and permitted by Arizona Statutes; and



## **Amendment No. 2 Ordinance 2008-1**

Change ARTICLE II, Section 217 to read as follows:

### **Section 217 – District Public Records**

The District may make certain documents and reports generally available to the public by placing them on the District's website. The type of document or specific documents to be made available on the website will be determined by the District (or by statute).

Public records of the District not available on its website are available for public inspection upon receipt of a Request for Public Records form provided by the District. The request form and arrangements to view public records of the District may be made by contacting the District.

Copies of public documents will be made available at the rate of 25 cents per page, plus any postage or other cost of delivery.

Members of the public may listen to audio tapes of public meetings upon receipt of a Request for Public Records form provided by the District. The request form and arrangements to listen to audio tapes of the District may be made by contacting the District. Copies of such audio tapes will be made available upon payment of \$7.00, plus any postage or other cost of delivery.

In addition to the charge of 25 cents per page, if the request is for commercial purposes, a fair market value will also be charged.

Copies of requested documents or tapes may be mailed to the requesting party along with an invoice setting forth the charges for copying and delivery.
