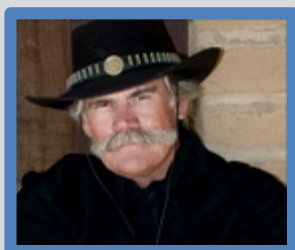

FISH FOR FOOD ROUND-UP

This year's Fish for Food Campaign was a huge success with a total of 1400 lbs of fish donated. Turners Members were spread out on several different boats. We limited out on Rockfish and had plenty of time to fish for other species before heading back to the Landing early. Once again the Mirage held up the festivities by coming in 20 minutes late but that was at least 20 minutes earlier than last year. Member Dick Giuliani was on that boat, having been switched off the Island Tak. Steve Kelly had to cancel the Island Tak's outing because of an ill deckhand. On the Pacific Islander were Will Ebersman, Ernie Branch, Carolyn Duncan and myself. William Davis sat this one out with his cast but was there at the Landing to meet & greet.

Carolyn was the hot stick, bringing up the first rockfish and then she managed to catch her limits and mine. Good thing as I could hardly catch anything. Carolyn did share her secret early on - drop down to where you think you should be and wait a minute. Meanwhile I kept following the Captain's directions to drop to the bottom and then reel up 20-30 feet. Fred Bernthal caught his share off fish on another boat and back at the Landing Don Merrill and Racquel DeCipeda arrived after a successful day of fishing. Carolyn was interviewed by KCET-TV while disembarking but her interview ended up on the newsroom floor. Fish and Wildlife were a huge presence at this year's event. Additional paper work was done by the members of Gold Coast Lady Anglers including a lot of recording of license numbers from those fishing. Then they labeled plastic bags to contain our filets with our license numbers and accounted for the number and type of fish on each person's bag. Each person had to carry their own bag to the Landing and hand the bag to Fish & Wildlife. This took a little extra time but wasn't as bad as it could have been. Some boats, such as the Mirage did not prep their fish in the bags and DFW boarded the boat.

This year's lunch featured wraps donated by a local restaurant and a brief raffle. Dick Giuliani was rewarded for his generosity by winning the final prize, the Accurate Reel.

I hope I didn't miss anyone in this article. Turners Club members need to be commended for attending this worthwhile event and providing fish for the needy.
