## SPANISH VALLEY WATER & SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

Regular Meeting -----September 28, 1983

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 P.M. ATTENDANCE at the District office by the Vice-Chairman, George White. Other Board members present were Neal Dalton and Dan Holyoak. Others present were Harry E. Snow, Attorney, David J. Bretzke, Executive Director, Mr. & Mrs. Joe Taylor, Neil Lien, John West, Douglas Holyoak, Bookkeeper, and Roberta R. Highland, Secretary.

Roberta Highland read the minutes of the Regular MINUTES meeting of September 14, 1983. Neal Dalton moved the minutes be approved as read. Dan Holyoak seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

EMPLOYEE TIME Employee time sheets were handed to the Board members present.

Joe Taylor stated that there was a spring on the JOE TAYLOR south side of his driveway, and when the sewer line was installed in the driveway, the spring stopped flowing. There is still water in the box, but not enough to flow. He suggested that we might dig below the sewer line level, and then gravel and install a clay barrier plus pipe. He also stated that he would rather have his spring restored than have water given him by the District. Dan Holyoak stated that he would take the hydrologist from the B.L.M. out to look at it, and Neal Dalton suggested that we contact Kedrick Somerville from the S.C. S. Joe Taylor stated that he also needed some work done on his fence line, and NEEDED that his lower driveway needed some gravel.

CLEAN-UP WORK

John West stated that he had gotten 18 signatures HECLA SUBon the contract, but that 8 had not signed. He stated that DIVISION they were having trouble over the 5 year clause for removal AGREEMENT of the tanks and hardware from the lot. Neal Dalton moved the clause be changed to one year. Dan Holyoak seconded. MOTION CARRIED. Harry Snow told John West that all he had to do was strike through the five on the original contract, insert a one and initial the change, and that the Distriat would also initial the change.

Neil Lien asked about the three peach trees on the lot. Neal Dalton moved that Neil Lien should buy 3 fruit trees at the Spanish Valley Nursery for half price. Dan Holyoak seconded. MOTION CARRIED.
