Huron Farmer Dies of Injuries

Tractor Mishap Is Fatal to R. N. Krohn

BAD AXE—Ray N. Krohn, 49, of Elkton, died this morning in the Bad Axe General hospital from injuries suffered in a farm accident Sept. 21.

The accident in which Krohn was fatally injured occurred on the farm of Charles Southworth, near Elkton, when Krohn was caught between the wheel and the fender of a moving tractor. Internal injuries and a fracture pelvis caused death.

He was born Dec. 15, 1899 in Oliver township, Huron county, and had operated a farm in the county all his life. He married the former Luella Stienman in April of 1923.

Surviving are his widow; three sons, William, Wayne, and Donald, all of Elkton; a daughter, Miss Marguerite Krohn, of Elkton; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. William Krohn, of Elkton; a twin brother, Roy, of Elkton, and three other brothers, Clarence and Howard, both of Elkton, and Glen, of Charlevoix; and one sister, Mrs. E. I. Steinhurst, of Elkton.
