The Commission signed the Intergovernmental Agreement with Region Homeland Security Regional Response Team. This agreement is to promote training, education and the safe efficient response to hazardous materials.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray met with the Commission and discussed bridge inspections that he has been doing with MODOT Engineer Austin Hibler. It was noted that water gaps are being tied to bridges. These gaps must be removed before work can be completed on bridges. Before the County would do this, they would notify the landowner.

The rock bid will be reviewed at the meeting of the 21<sup>st</sup> and opened on March 14<sup>th</sup>. The lateness is due to the concern of yellow rock being spread as sales tax rock.

Accounts payable were reviewed and approved.
