



Valley Center Vaquero's 2020 Rail Show Rules and Regulations

USEF Rules will be followed, unless otherwise stated below:

- USEF rules will apply in any case not covered by VC Vaqueros Rail Show Rules.
- **All children under the age of 18 shall wear a certified helmet.**
- Lead line entrants may not cross enter into ANY riding, halter or showmanship classes.
- Decisions of Judge and Show Secretary are final.
- Horse and Rider combinations entered in to two gait classes may not enter three gait classes, and vice versa.
- Gag bits are NOT to be used at any time in any class.
- Snaffle bits and hackamore/bosal may be used on any age horse, ridden two handed.
- Shank bits may be used on any age horse, ridden single handed, unless riding a gaited horse.
- No martingales or ties downs of any kind are allowed.
- Classes may be combined, split, or cancelled at the discretion of the Show Secretary.
- No stallions shall be ridden by any rider under the age of 18.

Valley Center Vaqueros 2020 Daily High Point Rules and Regulations

- Nomination forms must be completed and paid for prior to the start of the chosen discipline. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
- You may enter more than one division. The entry fee is \$15 per division and you must complete a separate nomination form (ie: each age/open and discipline). See below for Country Pleasure and Discipline Rail declarations.
- For Open classes, Country Pleasure and Discipline Rail, you **MUST** declare at the time of registration which division you want your points to apply to. Points may only be applied to one division. (ie; You enter W/T English 14-17 & W/T English Open, you can only apply the points to 14-17 division OR the open division.) You may change where your points are allotted at each individual show, but not once the chosen discipline has started.
