NEIGHBORHOOD RENTALS: As everyone should already know this neighborhood is owner occupied. Rentals are prohibited. We have this requirement in our covenants because property values are negatively affected when a neighborhood is more than 10% rentals. If a neighborhood has too many renters lenders will not loan money to prospective home buyers which puts the seller in the difficult position of having to sell to a cash only buyer. There are some neighborhoods across Satellite Blvd and in the Berkeley Lake areas that are in this position. One home on Satellite had to take a cash offer on \$1.00, yes \$1.00! Our neighborhood has already reached the 10% mark and anyone who tries to rent their home will be fined. Prohibiting rentals is the only way to protect our property values.

TRASH CANS: I sure do wish that trash companies could design a trash can that looked like a botanical garden on wheels! When neighbors leave them out, we would be looking at beautiful scenery instead of the heap of blue plastic that sticks out like a sore thumb. Our covenants state that trash cans must be stored out of view from the street and surrounding properties. The ideal place is in your garage or in a fenced area.

OUR STREET LIGHTS: If a street light near your home has gone out, please call Jackson Electric and give them the number on the pole. They will come out quickly to replace the bulb. Also the street lights are there to provide light and security throughout the neighborhood, so if you have a tree that has grown too high and blocks the light, please trim those trees. The county has the authority to trim them and they do not have to do a nice job, I've seen that many times. If you want it to look nice, trim them yourselves.

NEWSPAPERS, READ THEM AND RECYCLE THEM: Have you seen your neighbors literally trip over the stack of newspapers in their own driveway? It's a tiny effort to pick these up when you arrive home or on your way to the mailbox and it's much easier to pick them up right away before they get soaked by the rain and turn to mush.

MAINTAINING YOUR YARD: The word "maintain" doesn't mean you take care of your lawn when you get a violation letter, it means always maintain. Yards that are not maintained decrease property values of every single neighbor. Even when the grass stops growing at the end of summer, the weeds do not. Please keep those under control all year long. Also leaves falling from your trees can start now and continue through winter, please keep them raked and from blowing into your neighbor's lawn or the street.

FERTILIZE AND WEED CONTROL: Watch for front entry signs that are placed for your convenience. They are there to remind you of the best time to apply fertilizer and weed control. Our website myfairlake.com also has a schedule to keep you up to date. And don't we all really want a lawn like the Douglas's on Fairway View Ct? Lawn envy!

WATER: This season we have had an abundance of rain so most of us have not had to use irrigation systems; Mother Nature helped us out on that one. But make sure you pay attention to future drought restrictions that may apply.

MOW: Height of grass should be maintained at 3"

EDGE: Sidewalks and driveways are not maintained if grass is growing into the cement. Please make sure you are maintaining those areas.

CLEAN UP: Leaving grass lying on the driveways, sidewalks or blown into the road is not clean up. It looks messy and those who blow it into the road end up clogging our storm drains. Blow your clippings into your natural areas or bag them for Waste Pro to pick up curb side.
