

# Mrs. Lorne Gascho

1903 — 1952

Mrs. Lorne Gascho, 48, passed away Friday at her home in Elkton following a long illness.

Mrs. Gascho was born Grace Elizabeth Coulter on October 31, 1903, in London, England, and came to Detroit when she was 16 years of age.
