APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY STATE PERMIT TO CARRY PISTOL OR REVOLVERS

1. Completely fill out CT. State form DPS-799-C Temporary State Permit to Carry Pistol / Revolver and have it **NOTARIZED**.
 - a) Applicant must be 21 years of age
 - b) Permit is valid for 60 days – cannot be renewed.
 - c) Must reapply to local authority if expired without obtaining state permit
 - d) Valid only to carry firearms, NOT valid for purchase of firearms
2. A member of the Plainfield Police Department must fingerprint you.
3. A **certified check or money order for \$158.25** made payable to the “Town of Plainfield” for fingerprint processing, application processing, and background check. This certified check or money covers the following:
 - a) \$13.25 for FBI Background Check
 - b) \$75.00 for State of Connecticut Background Check
 - c) \$70.00 for Town of Plainfield Background Check and Application Processing
4. Required Paperwork/Documentation:
 - a) Notarized DPS-799-C Temporary State Permit Application Completed
 - b) Copy of your certificate of competence with a handgun.
 - c) Certified copy of Birth Certificate
 - d) Valid State issued photo Identification Card

*Once the **State Police & FBI** advises this department that you do not have a criminal record (Approximately 8 Weeks) that would prevent the issuance of a Temporary State Pistol Permit, and the Plainfield Police Department has completed a full background check; a Temporary State Pistol Permit will be issued. You will then have 60 days to go to Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection to obtain your state pistol permit. For additional information please visit www.ct.gov.*
