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## Pilot Assignments Decreasing Fast

$\checkmark$ May 2019 Decreased 8.6\% from May 2018
Annualized Rate of Assignment Loss equals 4.7 Fewer Pilots at TAL
$\checkmark$ June 2019 Decreased 13.4\% from June 2018
Annualized Rate of Assignment Loss equals 7.9 Fewer Pilots at TAL
Total annualized loss of 1,140 assignments

## Conclusion

$\checkmark$ No Need to Change Number of Pilots at This Time

- Rapid decrease of assignments bears monitoring

Recommend BPC Address Management of Pilotage Resources to Comply with Pilotage Act

- Maximize on watch pilots being available for ship assignments
- Eliminate double counting transition days
- Reform management policies that reduce pilot availability
