Introduction

- During this period ACCOTS will be running as normal although on some days there may be slightly reduced clinical transfer team coverage.
- Please refer all patients as usual to 0300 200 1100 or on the Referapatient system.


Capacity Transfers

Following discussion with the Regional NHSE Team, ACCOTS will:

NOT be routinely taking capacity transfer requests during the period of IA

- The rationale for this is that all acute trusts will be under sustained pressure during this
 period of IA and therefore managing ACC capacity with patient transfers will be
 challenging and most importantly, will likely not provide benefit to the patients transferred
- It is recognised however, that this four-day strike and it's timing may create significantly greater challenges than the previous period of IA in March.
- There may, therefore, be specific situations in which capacity transfers becomes a critical step in ensuring ongoing patient safety
- If any trust is in a position where they feel the situation is unsafe within their Adult Critical Care Unit and require mutual aid, this must be raised via the trust Incident Command Centre (ICC) to the NHSE Midlands Regional Incident Command Centre (RICC), following the below process:
