BUILDING & GROUNDS

other NEWS

The following by-law changes have been approved by the board and will be voted on at the February 21st chapter meeting:

1. Article IV, section 8 which states "No member or employee of the Game Commission, Fish Commission, Sanitary Water Board or Water and Power Resources Board, or any similar State or Local agency shall be eligible to hold any office in the chapter." will be removed in it's entirety.

2. Article I, Section 1, will be changed from:

1. Admission Requirements:

- A. An applicant must be 18 years of age or older.
- An applicant and one of his sponsors must attend one open meeting and be acknowledged as a guest before a membership application shall be filed. Sponsor and guest must sign log book.
 - An applicant must attend an orientation as approved by the Board before presenting an application for membership.
- B. An applicant shall have two sponsors who are members of this chapter in good standing for at least two (2) years.
- A member in good standing is one whose current dues are paid.
- C. Money for dues and initiation fees must accompany all applications when they are presented to the Chairman of the Membership Committee.
- D. Each application must be individually approved by a two-thirds vote of the Board who are present at any Board meeting.
- E. An application shall be forwarded to the Membership Chairman for processing.
- F. Each application must thereafter be approved by a majority vote of the members in good standing of the Senior chapter present at a chapter meeting.
- G. A decision not to admit an applicant at any stage shall be final.

To:

- Admission requirements:
 - An applicant must be 18 years of age or older.
 - An applicant must attend at least one chapter work detail.
 - An applicant must attend an orientation.
 - Money for dues and initiation fees must accompany all applications when they are presented to the membership committee.
 - The membership committee will conduct background checks, and investigate applicants further if needed, and report all findings to the Board. The applicant may be asked to attend a Board meeting if clarification is needed.
 - Each application must be individually approved by a two-thirds vote of the Board who are present at any Board meeting.
 - Each applicant must be introduced to the membership at a chapter meeting, or if unable, attend a second chapter work detail, or other organized club event where Members may meet them before being voted on by the membership.
 - Each application must thereafter be approved by a majority vote of the members of the senior chapter present at a chapter meeting.
