1. There is hereby established a no parking or standing zone beginning 60 feet east of the intersection of Erie Street and Park Avenue, Village of Cohocton, eastward on Park Avenue 42.8 feet on the southern side of the street from the traveled portion of the street to the lands occupied by the Cohocton Central School.
2. Parking or standing shall be prohibited in said zone.
3. Violators shall be penalized by \$5.00 for first offense, \$10.00 for second and \$25.00 for all additional offenses.
4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon proper filing with the Secretary of State.
