DESCRIPTION: Groves Spitfire bows are quite rare and hard to come by. It is extremely rare to find a Spitfire Target model like this one, especially in a 45# draw weight. Groves were known for their high end high-performance bows. This Spitfire Target is a Dyna-Stressed model (meaning it was one of the fastest recurves of its era). Great looking and performing bow. Beautiful high quality Rosewood riser. The limbs are a uniform color, but the camera shot made them a little more white or yellow, depending on the pic. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. The only flaw in this bow that keeps it from being in near mint condition is a repaired scrape that ran along the edge of the lower back limb in the middle. This is shown in the 2 pics on the last page. Up close you can see the repair and the slight difference in limb color. But from a few feet away it doesn't show. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was also put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. It was also recently taken to the field and shot tested. It is a superior shooter.

Comes with a new string.















Repaired edge
