WILLIAM LYON PHELPS DIES AT HIS NEW HAVEN HOME

Dr. William Lyon Phelps, 78, died at his home in New Haven, Conn., early Saturday morning of last week. Funeral services were held Monday afternoon and burial was in Grove Street Cemetery, near Yale University. He had been in ill health since June, when he suffered a stroke, and appeared to be improving, but early in the week had a relapse.

Dr. Phelps was professor emeritus of English at Yale University, retir-

ing a number of years ago.

Professor Phelps was well known in Huron county, having for a number of years conducted services in the Huron City Methodist church during the summer months, when he was staying at Seven Gables, his summer home. People would come from long distances to attend these Sunday afternoon services.

Professor Phelps was united in marriage to Annabel Hubbard, daughter of a pioneer lumberman of Huron county in 1892. Mrs. Phelps

died in 1939.
