Dear Resident,

Please read the following Gate information carefully. If you still have questions, we encourage you to attend a **Q&A meeting on Wednesday, December 13, 2017 at 3:00 pm**. The meeting will be on Facebook LIVE for those of you who would like to participate from home.

Please drive your car to the Clubhouse to have your barcode applied to your car(s). This must be completed by the office to ensure proper placement. No exceptions. Please make every effort to come when scheduled.

Bar Code Application Dates:

Avenue A – K	Thursday, December 14	12:00 – 3:00
Avenue L – V inc. Hague	Friday, December 15	12:00 – 3:00
Last Call	Saturday, December 16	9:00 – 11:00

The Gates will be activated at sundown on Monday, December 18, 2017

If you miss the dates above, please come to the office and we will do our best to accommodate you on the spot.

If you have no personal vehicle, we will issue you a transportable bar code that you can keep with you for entry during evening hours. Please pick up on the same day and time slots above. These will not be issued in addition to those residents with a vehicle. No exceptions.

The gates at Amsterdam Blvd. and Holland Blvd. will be open from sunrise to sunset. At sunset daily, those gates will automatically close. Your barcode will allow entrance and exit through both of those gates.

Visitors during the evening hours must use the Holland Blvd. gated access.

The gate at Bayshore Gardens Pkwy. (Presbyterian Villas) will remain closed at all times and accessible only by a remote clicker that is available to purchase for \$25. Please be aware that this is a very long and slow gate and is not designed for constant use. Therefore, we are allowing the closest residents on T, Hague, U and V to make the first reservations for clickers – one per household. Please call, email or stop by to make your reservation. You will receive it when you get your barcode and pay your \$25 (check to BWV). Others may make a request and we will accommodate based on proximity to the gate.

Short Term Residents and Long Term Guests will be issued a temporary barcode pass with a \$20 refundable cash deposit and copy of Driver's License. No exceptions.

If you've listed your cell phone as your gate entry phone number, you can let yourself in by selecting your name at the gate access on Holland Blvd. and follow the prompts. If you find yourself locked out for whatever reason, you can scroll for an Emergency Access and be buzzed in.

The pedestrian gate at T and Hague is operated by a numbered key pad. **Your code is 0603C**. We may change this periodically, with notice, if it becomes clear that non-residents are using the gate. **DO NOT give away this code to any non-resident.**

Visitors will have evening entry through the Holland Blvd. entrance only.

Gate Introduction

Entry to your complex is controlled by a Telephone Entry System. Please read and refer to these instructions for details on using the system. These instructions will explain how to take calls and grant access to visitors as well as how to use any entry codes and wireless remote controls issued to you.

Visitor Calling

When a visitor desires to enter your complex, *you* will have control whether the visitor will be allowed to enter or not. Your name has been entered and a personal directory number has been reserved in the entry system.

A visitor can view an alphabetic list of all the names on the entry system's display. When the visitor selects your name, your directory number is displayed. When the visitor enters your directory number, the system will automatically call you. *Your telephone number will never be displayed to the visitor.* If the visitor already knows your directory number, they can press ☎ immediately, then enter your directory number. If you are currently using the telephone, and do not have call waiting, the system's display will tell the visitor your line is busy (if you have call waiting, simply switch to the visitor, grant or deny access, then switch back to your call).

Responding to a Visitor's Call

When you answer a visitor's call, talk to the visitor and decide if you want to let them enter or not. There is a limited time allowed for the call. During the last ten seconds allowed, beeps will sound to warn you of the limited time.

Press 9 to unlock the gate where the system is located, then hang up

Press * or just hang up to disconnect the visitor *without* granting access
