(April 23, 1923 - January 20, 2011)



Frances Lucille McBride, 87, of Lake Township, died suddenly Thursday, January 20, 2011 at Bay Regional Medical Center in Bay City.

Frances was the seventh of nine children born to the late Robert and Mabel (Mayhew) Hyzer on April 23, 1923. She grew up on a farm north of Pinnebog and attended Pinnebog School.
