## The Highwaymen - Songs & Stories with Matt York

Longtime New England musician/author Matt York will perform the songs of Johnny Cash, Willie Nelson, Kris Kristofferson and Waylon Jennings and tell stories of their careers.

While the four songwriting legends joined forces in the 1980's to form the country supergroup The Highwaymen, they had each established themselves as stars and their careers intersected many times from the 1960's. York was recently nominated for the Boston Music Award for Best Country Artist and his album *Gently Used* was just named one of the Patriot Ledger's best albums of 2022.
