

**Town of Stratton
Selectmen's Meeting
October 12, 2015**

Present: Selectmen: Al Dupell, Larry Bills, Chris Liller, Greg Marcucci and Kevin Robinson; and Clerk – Kent Young.

Al Dupell called the meeting to order at 7:30pm. Orders were reviewed and signed.

Modifications to the Agenda: No modifications were made.

Road Crew Issues: Guardrails: Chris Liller reported that there had been a chance to get some guardrail work completed this fall; however, it will likely be postponed to the spring. **Culverts** – Larry Bills has been unable to evaluate the removal of the old culverts at Kidder Brook. Chris Liller will see if Evergreen Recycling, Inc. can take them. **Rec. Area Fire Pit:** Chris Liller reported that LBM Masonry will build a new fireplace beside the skating rink next spring. **Town Truck:** The body on the new F550 should be installed and ready for pickup in the coming week. **Kelley Stand Parking Lot:** The Selectmen agreed to have the Road Crew add fill to the hole in the access to the Parking Lot so that it can be plowed this winter.

Town Hall: The Selectmen reviewed a drawing of the new sign and agreed to have the wording removed around the logo, as it is redundant with the main wording on the sign and also agreed with the colors – the background is to be a dark green. The Clerk will forward this information to Wood Signs and request information concerning the placement of the columns, which have arrived, and information concerning the mounting brackets.

Minutes: Greg Marcucci moved to approve the Selectmen's minutes of September 28, 2015. Larry Bills seconded the motion – all concurred and the minutes were approved.

Listers' Stipulation: The Selectmen reviewed and approved by signing a Listers' stipulation which removes the property of Rosanna Warren from the Current Use Program, resulting in a change to the taxable Grand List Value of this property.

Adjourn: Larry Bills motioned to adjourn at 8:05p.m.. Chris Liller seconded. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned.
