Aloha Kakou,

We had a good turnout and good conversations last Sunday (May 26) for the study of the Draft Social Statement on Civic Life and Faith. It was very civil. We even laughed and joked with each other and no one shouted "Heresy!" or "Repent!" As we pondered the theological and ethical grounds of our faith in a civil society, I came away feeling hopeful. Small moves against destruction.

Also, forgive me, but I keep having to intentionally say "Civic Life," because I keep hearing echoes in my head calling it "Civic Strife"! Oh, the times we live in!

As we await the verdict in the first criminal trial of a former US President, a number of you have expressed your anxiety about how it will go and what it will mean whatever the verdict. Will there be violence?

I think that anxiety is a symptom of a wider anxiety in our polarized society, especially over so many civil rights that we took for granted and are now in danger of losing. I won't bother to list them because you know what they are. I also think that social change, especially around issues of injustice is badly

needed, but that the pace of change is scaring people. It leaves them with a sense of anxiety about a perceived chaos. Their worldviews have changed and they do not know quite how to cope with that change. This leaves people vulnerable to extremism and even violence.

What is our response as Christians attached in various ways to the Lutheran Movement? I think we need to ask what it means to live by grace and love our neighbor, what it means to seek justice, what it means to pick up our cross and follow Jesus. And what it means on Wednesday, November 6th, the day after the presidential election, to be peacemakers.

"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God." Matthew 5:9
