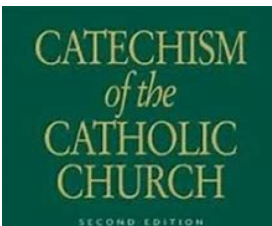

THE OLD LAW
