Vineyard and Terroir

- Location: Saint-André du Bois, Bordeaux, Right Bank of Garonne River
- **Soil Type**: A combination of limestone covered with gravel soils on slopes, clay-limestone mid-slope, and fine gravel mixed with silica at the foot of the slopes.
- **Viticulture Practices:** Sustainable and organic farming practices aimed at preserving the natural balance of the vineyard and enhancing the expression of the terroir.



Winemaking

- Harvest: The grapes were harvested at the peak of ripeness, followed by meticulous sorting to ensure only the best grapes were used.
- Vinification: Traditional winemaking methods were employed, including temperature-controlled fermentation at 30°C to optimize extraction.
 Post-fermentation, the grape skins were pressed in a pneumatic press to extract supple, ripe tannins.
- Aging: The wine underwent malolactic fermentation in vats and was aged for 6 months before bottling.





Tasting Notes

- Appearance: The wine displays a strong yet refined color, indicative of the significant proportion of Cabernet Franc in the blend.
- Aroma: An expressive nose with notes of ripe fruit and a variety of spices, showcasing both freshness and ripeness.
- Palate: On the palate, this wine offers charming fullness, smoothness, and surprising depth, making it a delightful and wellrounded experience.



Food Pairing

 Recommended Pairings: Ideal with roasted duck, braised short ribs, or hearty dishes like cassoulet. Also pairs well with mature cheddar.
