**UNITED STATES’ SECOND MOTION TO ENFORCE  
CONSENT DECREE AND FOR STIPULATED PENALTIES**

The United States, by its attorneys and on behalf of the United States Environmental Protection Agency, hereby moves the Court to enforce the terms of the Consent Decree that this Court entered on September 23, 1996, and for stipulated penalties. As explained in the supporting Memorandum of Law, Defendants have cleared, ditched, drained, plowed, and planted approximately eighteen (18) acres of wetlands, causing the unpermitted discharge of pollutants into waters of the United States that were required to be restored pursuant to the Consent Decree, violating both the Consent Decree and the Clean Water Act.

Accordingly, the United States respectfully requests that the Court issue an Order enforcing the Consent Decree by requiring Defendants to: (1) restore the wetlands; (2) comply with the permanent injunction; (3) pay the stipulated penalties required by the Consent Decree; (4) reimburse the United States for fees and costs incurred by the United States in seeking enforcement of the Consent Decree; and (5) grant any other monetary and injunctive relief that the Court deems appropriate. Further, the United States requests that the Court modify the

Consent Decree to increase the stipulated penalties to deter Defendants from violating the  
Consent Decree in the future.
