Rules for acquiring extra Paul Harris Fellow

(PHF) recognition points:

- Contributions must be made to the Annual Fund.
- Rotarian's contributions from \$100 to \$500 will be matched with PHF recognition points one for one.
- Contributions must be made online on the Rotary International My Rotary website on Tuesday, April 4th.
- Your My Rotary account must be set up in advance at least the week before if you do not already have an account.
- Rotarians who are Paul Harris Fellows +8 are not eligible for recognition points because such points are not valid toward Major Donor status.
