

## Town of Baldwin, Maine SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, MAY 28TH, 2024, 6:00 P.M.

## 1. Review/ Approve minutes.

Dale Miner moved to accept and approve May 14th, 2024, minutes as written. Robert Flint seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the minutes.

## 2. Review/ Approve warrant.

Robert Flint moved to accept and approve the May 28th, 2024, warrant. Dale Miner seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the warrant.

- 3. <u>Fire Chief Position:</u> Selectman, Jim Dolloff noted receipt of email from Standish Fire Chief, Rob Caron inquiring about the status of Baldwin's Fire Chief position. Assistant Fire Chief, Chris Harrington, confirmed that Chief, Steven Sanders is currently still in the area and active as Chief. Jim Dolloff will respond to Chief Caron's email.
- 4. Road Commissioner, Chris Harrington: Chris confirmed that he is back to work after a couple weeks of medical leave. Chris reports that Charlie from Allstate called with plans to push paving to end of July. Chis notes that he left a returned message stating the contract states the paving would commence July 1<sup>st</sup>. Jim inquired about the status of repair work to Cram Road. Chris will add Cram Road to the work schedule. The road crew continues to work on brush clean-up. Summer work plans include ditching and culvert work on Douglas Hill Road.

Administrative Assistant, Robyn Anderson received a call from a girl scout leader seeking space to hold troop meetings in the fall. The troop is comprised of girls from the SAD 55 school district. The Selectmen agreed the current space utilized by another girl scout troop could be shared.
