"Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you." Matthew 6:6

I heard a very interesting opinion the other day. The opinion came from a commentator arguing for less transparency and more secrecy in our government. On the surface that sounds ridiculous. It sounds like the exact opposite of what most of us would want, because we believe that it is open transparency that keeps individuals honest. We believe that if someone, particularly a politician, is able to work in secret they will be more corrupt, and our experiences support this conclusion. But the opinion I heard was in response to a televised congressional oversight hearing in which no actual oversight occurred. The commentator was blaming the lack of meaningful discourse on the transparency of the television cameras that aired the hearing. The argument actually makes some sense, that the politicians acted differently because of the cameras instead of using their time for advancing the meeting's agenda. The politicians used their time to make outrageous statements or fancy speeches trying to land a good sound bite. The result was that rather than do the actual work of applying congressional oversight to the agency in question the two dozen congressional members got to feel important on national television. I think the commentator is right in this particular situation. The same hearing happening behind closed doors would probably have proved more meaningful and helpful for the agency being reviewed. But instead of thoughtful political discourse that could have advanced our nation forward, we received a room full of people trying to out perform one another in a grandiose sort of way. The congressional members were show boating by trying to keep the focus on them individually rather than the issues or solutions available.

These political leaders seem to be a modern example of what Jesus instructs us against in Matthew six. The beginning of Matthew six consists of Jesus instructing his followers "to be careful not to do [their] acts of righteousness in front of other [people]". Jesus uses the example of sounding the trumpet when helping those in need to draw the publics attention to how good they are; or to pray loudly on the street corner with lots of fancy words so that others will think they are very religious. This is concluded with the famous, 'they have received their reward' statement. The take away is clearly established when Jesus tells us to do these things in secret, and our Heavenly Father who sees what is done in secret will reward us. It is a reminder to live for God and not to try to make ourselves seem better than we are.

Now, I don't know if having our politicians do everything in secrecy behind closed doors is a reasonable solution to our nation's problems. It probably is not. But I do know that we as individuals should consider for ourselves whether our public actions and our private actions are both pleasing to the God we love and serve. Is the version of ourselves that we present publicly to the world focused on serving God or building ourselves up? Are the things we do in private when no one is watching; are they pleasing to the God who sees all? Many people act differently depending on who is in the room with them at the time. I think we would all do better to remember that God sees who we are in secret just as clearly as God sees who we present ourselves to be in public. And I believe that when we accept this truth, that God knows all, we will experience the freedom of not having to pretend to be something we are not. Instead we can be the person God is calling us to be, both in secret and in public.

10. Approved the ordering of a new Ice Machine for the kitchen, not to exceed \$700


11. No Session Meeting is scheduled for the month of July. Next regular meeting is August 17




