Ordinance number 549

An Ordinance providing for the calling of an election to vote on a proposition to issue bonds of the City of Garnett, Kansas, for the purpose of purchasing, constructing or extending electric light works, for the City of Garnett and its inhabitants with electric light, heat, and power; also to repeal ordinance number 456 and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance,

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Garnett,

Section one. That the Mayor and city clerk are ^{herby} authorized and instructed to call an election, submitting to the electors of the City of Garnett, a proposition to issue bonds of the City of Garnett to the amount of twenty thousand dollars, for the purpose of purchasing, constructing or extending electric light works, for the purpose of supplying the City of Garnett and its inhabitants, with electric light, heat and power.

Section two. That ordinance number 456, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section three. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the City Council, approval by the Mayor and publication in the official ^{paper}, the Evening Review.
