BEDFORD — The City of Bedford conducted a ribbon cutting and dedication to commemorate Earth Day for its newly relocated Community Garden at Fifth and H streets on April 19.

Bedford Urban Enterprise Association (BUEA) presented the nearly 3-acre site to the city, which has allocated its care to the city parks department.

Live Well Lawrence County and Purdue Extension partnered with the city to ready the site and will assist in its maintenance, according to Bedford Parks Director Barry Jeskewich.




The site should be ready to welcome gardeners by May 13.
