The City of Lebanon is accepting applications to fill the position of Environmental Technician in the Water Distribution & Collections Division of the Department of Public Works. The successful candidate must be a highly motivated team player. The primary areas of responsibility will be maintenance, inspections and emergency repairs on the water distribution system and the storm and sanitary sewer collection systems. The successful candidate must have the ability to work in all weather conditions. General Hours of work are Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Candidates must also be available for emergency response outside of the general work hours during the week and on weekends. The position requires that the employee be on a scheduled weekly rotation of paid standby status with the ability to report to work within 30 minutes of notification. Applicants must be 18 years of age, display excellent written and verbal communication skills and possess an Ohio-Class A or B Commercial Driver's License with air brake and tanker endorsements or be able to obtain one within 6 months of hire. Ohio EPA certification in Water/Wastewater treatment, distribution, or collection is required within three years. Experience in public water distribution and/or collections system infrastructure repairs and construction is a plus. The starting pay range is \$14.42 - \$20.20 per hour DOQ.
