REGIONAL PLANNING REPORT:

No Hocking issues.

ZONING:

Rich Hogle reported there were 4 permits for the month. He stated he has had several calls and issues to address.

CORRESPONDENCE FROM THE FISCAL OFFICER:

Minutes from the August Meeting being read prior by the Board were approved as read, so moved by Trustee Wolfe and seconded by Trustee Shaw. All were in favor with 3 ayes and no negative votes, motion passed. Fiscal Officer Ressler asked for a resolution to accept the Coronavirus aid relief from the county auditor for funds to be expended for COVID related

expenditures only. Trustee Wolfe motioned to accept the resolution and Trustee Shaw seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Shaw– Yes, Wolfe- Yes.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Fire Department reported monthly runs so far have been 18 fire and 34 EMS for a total of 560 runs YTD. Mutual aid was provided to Amanda, Berne, Clearcreek, and Lancaster. A total of 3 runs to SCI. There were three applicants interviewed for part time positions. Only one has been hired. Engine Tanker 652 is out of service due to mechanical issues.

OLD BUSINESS

1. The county will keep Hocking Township informed as to the progress of the OPWC on Meister Road.
2. Hocking Township will continue to monitor Stonewall Cemetery Road and Stepath Mound Lane for erosion.
3. Marathon Mini Mart is moving along at Delmont Road and Route 22.
4. Trustee Ellinger spoke with the county and the army corps of engineers about the muddy prairie run creek on Pleasant Valley. Waiting on a reply. The bank is eroding towards the road.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. MP Dory to replace both sides of the guardrail on Mill Road. Trustee Wolfe motioned to budget for \$4,372.50 to replace the guardrail. Trustee Shaw seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Shaw– Yes, Wolfe- Yes. Motion approved
2. Trustee Wolfe motioned to submit the appropriate amendments in the zoning resolution for the conditional use, variances, and rezoning to the Regional Planning for their review and recommendation. Trustee Shaw seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Shaw– Yes, Wolfe- Yes. Motion approved. After Regional Planning’s approval and recommendation, Hocking Township will follow the necessary steps to change Hocking Townships Zoning resolution. This change will permit a possible investor the opportunity



3. Shelley Company will complete the 2020 paving project on Westfall Road. A meeting will be set up on October 2, 2020 at 9:00am with McKee Paving to address the issues with their paving project.
4. The health department is asking for approval for a treated discharge to a ditch on Hopewell Church Road. Trustee Shaw motioned to approve the discharge to the ditch. Trustee Wolfe seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Shaw– Yes, Wolfe- Yes. Motion approved.

Trustee Shaw moved to pay the warrants for the month seconded by Trustee Wolfe. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Shaw– Yes, Wolfe- Yes. Motion approved.


There being no further business to discuss Trustee Ellinger motioned to adjourn and Trustee Wolfe seconded the motion.
