SPANISH VALLEY WATER & SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT Regular Meeting ----- January 25, 1984

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, ATTENDANCE W. Darwin Gilger, at 7:00 P.M. at the District office. Other Board members present were Linda McKinney, George White, Neal Dalton and Dan Holyoak.

Others present were David J. Bretzke, Executive Director, Dale Pierson, District Maintenance Man, Douglas Holyoak, Bookkeeper, and Roberta Highland, secretary.

Roberta Highland read the minutes of the meeting MINUTES of January 11, 1984. Dan Holyoak moved the minutes be approved as read. George White seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Dale Pierson reported that several meters had frozen, and gave the Board an illustration of how the meter yoke was set in a meter pit.

Dan Holyoak reported that the Grand County Waster Conservancy District was considering the purchase of a building, and if the purchase is completed, the District will have plenty of storage room

David Bretzke asked the Board if the District should send out a letter to residents notifying them of the new Ordinance, suggesting they contact contractors, and that they can expect to be billed soon. The Board agreed, and directed the staff to complete a map of all land along the line as soon as possible, so that these people can be notified.

George White moved the Staff prepare an ordinance accepting the County Ordinance, and setting forth a payment schedule as outlined in the papers, and prorating the commercial and multi-family connections at the same rate. Dan Holyoak seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Dan Holyoak reported that he and Dale had attended the lunch meeting with Lignell and the Moab Community Development Agency on January 12, 1984, and that Dale had showed them maps of the water, sewer and irrigation lines, but that nothing had been said about the price and no requests for grants or special rates had been made.

George White reported that the Conservancy District is looking into sources to upgrade the water sup- DEVELOPMENT ply, and developing new sources of both culinary and irrigation water.

David Bretzke reported that Stratton Bros. had replied to our latest letter in a negative way, and recom- BROS. REPLY mended the District not to pay any more until a settlement can be made. MOTION CARRIED. It was suggested Harry Snow handle all correspondence with the contractor and engineer until this matter is settled.

ENGINEERING COSTS & BILL

David reported that Mrs. Milton Walston had SEWER FEE requested a discount on her sewer bill if she paid it six DISCOUNTS months or a year in advance. The Board agreed not to give any discounts.

Billing for water fees was discussed, and whether or not Dale estimated bills in very cold weather to avoid freezing of meters. It was reported the District does this, usually in December or January. The Board recommended that we monitor winter temperatures and not read meters when danger of breaking the frost barrier was evident.
