1906 – 1999

Leona Grace Shetler, age 92 of Pigeon, passed away Monday, July 19 at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon.

She was born in Archbold, Ohio on July 23, 1906, the daughter of the late Daniel L. and Ida (Aeschliman) Schrock. She was united in marriage to Henry Shetler on January 14, 1931 in Midland. He preceded her in death on July 2, 1973.
