

**RESOLUTION OF THE SUMMIT LAKE PAIUTE COUNCIL
SUMMIT LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE**

RESOLUTION NO.: SL - 35 - 2024

**TITLE: APPROVAL TO ACCEPT THE FY2024 BUREAU OF INDIAN
AFFAIRS FISH WILDLIFE AND PARK PROJECT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to Section 16 of Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 8, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Council; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is fully authorized to act of behalf of its Tribal Members in matters arising under the Indian Self-Determination Act of 1975, P. L. 93-638, as amended, 25 U.S.C. 450 et. Seq (hereby the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has been organized to represent, develop, protect, and advance the views, interest, education, resources, and general welfare of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe membership; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has the responsibility for the general welfare of its tribal membership including tribal natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council is the duly constituted governing body within the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council supports natural resources management that protects, conserves, and enhances plants and wildlife native to the Summit Lake basin and aboriginal area of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has organized a Natural Resources Department (NRD) to provide technical expertise and services to manage air, water, soil, fish, wildlife, and plants within the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation and off Reservation areas considered the aboriginal homeland of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the SLPT was awarded and wishes to accept Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) FY2024 Fish Wildlife and Parks Project Funds of \$114,061 for three projects to improve the safety, efficiency, and longevity of the fish trap facility; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe desires to enter into a P. L. 93-638 contract with the Department of Interior for the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) FY2024 Fish Wildlife and Parks Project Funds referenced above;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this resolution shall remain in effect for until such a time as this resolution has been expressly rescinded or modified by the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Paiute Council does not waive, alter, or otherwise diminish its Sovereign Immunity, whether expressed or implied, by virtue of this grant contract for any and all administrative or legal action which may arise directly or indirectly from the same. Furthermore, the Summit Lake Paiute Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairwoman to execute any instruments as may be necessary and appropriate to accomplish the above-mentioned actions in the name of and on behalf of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe.
