Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District, Chet Owen and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed all of those in attendance as they joined us for the opening prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then said by all in attendance.

East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the motion to approve today's agenda with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. All in favor. Motion carried. West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the minutes from October 26, 2021 meeting with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek reminded all that the Courthouse would be closed on December 31, 2021. Hours for Collector/Treasurer, Jessica Lee on December 30th will be 8 a.m. until 6 p.m.

The Commission discussed the annual Christmas Banquet to recognize County Employees. During this time recognition certificates would also be handed out from MAC (Missouri Association of Counties).

County Clerk, Melissa Meek asked if the maintenance crew could work on the Community Room in the basement since things were slowing down for them. The Commission ok'd the walls being repaired and repainted.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll will get in touch with Bob Dorton about cutting down the dead trees at the nursing home.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White gave an update on Tri-County Health Dept. The Commission is very pleased with the efforts of Tri-County Health Department and its staff during these trying times.

Sheriff Kasey Keesaman met with the Commission to discuss staff, vehicles and equipment.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White discussed Region D and the purchase of a Commercial Shredder.

The Commission, Clerk and several office holders will attend the MAC Conference (Missouri Association of Counties) in the middle of November.

DDRJ (Davies DeKalb Regional Jail) Administrator Ed Howard met with the Commission to request funds from ARPA. The request was tabled at this time to gather more information on equipment they are requesting.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll advised that the historical signs for the schools were still going up. A QR Code will be added to the signs with a link to the DeKalb County Historical Society Museum web site.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray met with the Commission and discussed brush letters to be sent, equipment and the possibility of putting in a new culvert on Gridley. Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll made the motion to proceed with the culvert on Gridley with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. All in favor. Motion carried. The BEAP Study was completed on the bridge on Frost Rd. over Wheeler Creek NW of Cameron.

John Murphy of the Senior Tax Board met with the Commission to advise them of a vacancy within their board. The Commission advised that when the board finds a replacement to bring that name back and they will then appoint that person to fill their vacancy.

Bob Dorton will take care of trees needing cut down or pruned at Sunset as well as the Fair Building.

Collector/Treasurer, Jessica Lee presented the adjustment report to the Commission for them to review.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek advised the Commission that the Sales Tax for rock would need to be placed back on the ballot for the April 2022 election. She reminded them that this is just a renewal but would need to be approved by the voters in order to continue receiving it.
