## HOURS & SUPERVISION

All camps begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m. Students WILL NOT be supervised before 8:30 a.m. or after 4:30 p.m. An additional half-hour of supervision can be requested for \$10/day or \$50/week beyond the included half-hour of care.

## DROP OFF/PICK UP

Parents/Guardians should accompany students to the sign in table on the first day of camp. Parents may drop off/pick up their child(ren) at the Parent Pickup area located in the front of the campus for the remainder of the week.

## BREAKFAST / LUNCH

A "school-type" breakfast and lunch will be provided. Students can bring their own lunches. Low cost snacks and drinks will be available.

## INSTRUMENTS

Students must provide their own instruments for all instrumental music camps except Piano, Elementary Music Ensemble and Percussion (please bring drum sticks). Students should mark all of their own equipment with their name.

## CAMP FEE

Each camp fee is \$150 per week, which includes activities, breakfast, lunch, and a souvenir t-shirt. No refunds will be issued. Scholarships are available. All information is available on our website. An additional \$15 supply fee may apply to some classes.
