

Concealed Carry Endorsement Training (Illinois License)

Firearms Training Administrative Notes

- **No Ammunition is permitted in the classroom!** All ammunition, including boxed ammunition, ammunition in magazines/speed loaders is prohibited. All ammunition should be stored in a secure portion of a vehicle. **Do no enter the classroom with ammunition!**
- A student with a physical condition potentially affecting their safety, or the safety of others, during live exercises (fainting, dizziness, medication causing drowsiness, etc) must inform the instructors. All information will be held strictly confidential and is requested for your safety and the safety of others.
- No alcohol, tobacco or other drugs (prescription or non-prescription) are permitted on the premises.
- **All participants must keep their firearm's muzzle pointed in a safe direction at all times.**

Required Items – Class

- Properly executed Release Waiver Agreement (bottom of the application form)
- Course registration form, Course payment (cash or check payable to David Young)
- Valid form of government identification (passport, driver license, military ID)
- Pen, pencil, highlighter & notepad
- Sack lunch & snacks

Required Items – Range

- Pistol, semi-automatic action (with functional magazine) or revolver, well maintained and fully operational, stored in case, box or pistol rug.
- Ear protection
- Eye protection (clear, wrap around, ballistic safety glasses that meet ANSI Z87.1 or higher (stamped on temple).
- Prescription glasses may be used if shatterproof (polycarbonate) with side shields.
- 100 rounds of practice ammunition: New in manufacturer's box – No Reloads!
- 40 rounds of practice ammunition
- Hat, baseball style with bill to deflect ejected brass, must be worn on range
- Appropriate clothing – consistent with prevailing weather conditions. Range will be outdoors. Range exercises will be conducted in inclement weather unless a safety hazard exists.
- Pistol cleaning kit: cleaning supplies – bring cleaning equipment for your firearm(s).

Recommended Items for the Range

- Two fully functional magazines for your semi - automatic pistol
- Two fully functional speed loaders for your revolver
