RESOLUTION NO: SL – 36 - 2023

TITLE: SLPT Internet Access Policy

- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized, pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Statue 984), as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 08, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Tribal Council; and,
- **WHEREAS**, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is responsible for financial matters and the organization of operating policies to provide accountability of the benefits received by the Tribe on behalf of its members; and,
- WHEREAS, On March 11, 2021, the President signed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) (Public Law 117-2), which invests \$1.75 billion in American Indian and Alaska Native government programs administered under the oversight of the Department of the Interior's Assistant Secretary Indian Affairs (AS-IA); and,
- WHEREAS, Summit Lake Paiute Tribe was awarded funding to aid tribal government services, public safety and justice, social services, food, child welfare assistance, and other related expenses; and,
- WHEREAS, Summit Lake Paiute Tribe council decided to bring internet services to as many tribal member households as possible by partnering with T-Mobile for 5G Hotspots devices at no cost to the membership for a two (2) year time period; and,
- WHEREAS, Summit Lake Paiute Tribe Council understands the T-Mobile devices may not be able to equipped all households with internet access and the alternative would be to pay the internet for the ineligible tribal member households for the same two (2) year time frame; and
- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has deemed it to be in the best interest of the Tribe to provide internet access to as many tribal member households as possible from November 1, 2023 to October 31, 2025 at no cost to the tribal member; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Summit Lake Paiute Council, approves the SLPT Internet Access Policy to continue the operation with rules and guidelines set out.
