First Lesson: Ezekiel 17: 22-24 22

"This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I myself will take a shoot from the very top of a cedar and plant it; I will break off a tender sprig from its topmost shoots and plant it on a high and lofty mountain. 23On the mountain heights of Israel I will plant it; it will produce branches and bear fruit and become a splendid cedar. Birds of every kind will nest in it; they will find shelter in the shade of its branches. 24All the trees of the forest will know that I the LORD bring down the tall tree and make the low tree grow tall. I dry up the green tree and make the dry tree flourish. "It the LORD have spoken, and I will do it."

Second Lesson:2 Corinthians 5:6-

17 (Paul or his disciple writes)

So we are always confident; even though we know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord— 7 **for we** walk by faith, not by sight. 8 Yes, we do have confidence, and we would rather be away from the body and at home with the Lord. 9 So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please him. 10 For all of us must appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each may receive recompense for what has been done in the body, whether good or evil. 11 Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we try to persuade others; but we ourselves are well 2 known to God, and I hope that we are also well known to your consciences. 12 We are not commending ourselves to you again, but giving you an opportunity to boast about us, so that you may be able to answer those who boast in outward appearance and not in the heart. 13 For if we are beside ourselves, it is for God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you. 14 For the love of Christ urges us on, because we are convinced that one has died for all; therefore all have

died. 15 And he died for all, so that those who live might live no longer for themselves, but for him who died and was raised for them.

Gospel: Mark 4: 26-34 The Parable of the Growing Seed (Jesus had just told the disciples the parable of the of the seed that is growing secretly in the hearts of people and that no matter how slowly the seed of faith seems to grow, it is in the hands of the Creator therefore we should not be discouraged.) 26 Jesus also said, "This is what the kingdom of God is like. A man scatters seed on the ground. 27 Night and day, whether he sleeps or gets up, the seed sprouts and grows, though he does not know how. 28 All by itself the soil produces grain—first the stalk, then the head, then the full kernel in the head. 29 As soon as the grain is ripe, he puts the sickle to it, because the harvest has come."

The Parable of the Mustard Seed:

30 Again he said, "What shall we say the kingdom of God is like, or what parable shall we use to describe it? 31 It is **like a mustard seed**, which is the smallest of all seeds on earth. 32 Yet when planted, it grows and becomes the largest of all garden plants, with such big branches that the birds can perch in its shade." 33 With many similar parables Jesus spoke the word to them, as much as they could understand. 34 He did not say anything to them without using a parable. But **when he was alone** with his own disciples, **he explained everything.** The Word of the Lord, C: **Thanks be to God.**
