

TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS WITH HANDICAPPING CONDITIONS**POLICY**

Transportation shall be provided for handicapped children as provided by the Laws of the State of New York, the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education and the policies of the Board of Education.

Suitable transportation shall be provided to and from approved special classes for children designated as having a handicapping condition and in need of such transportation as may be prescribed by the District Committee on Special Education.

Transportation of Physically Disabled Students

Suitable transportation shall be provided to and from the school which a child legally attends when the child has a physical handicap, the duration of which is projected to be in excess of thirty (30) days from the date of the approval of the transportation request. In the case of children attending out-of-district, non-public schools, transportation shall be provided only to schools within the fifteen mile limit, as prescribed by State Law. In the case of a temporary disability, a definite date for termination of transportation shall be specified in the request for transportation.
