If you'd like to participate, please e-mail Pastor Jennifer and she will send you a link to sign in for these meetings (we're hoping to use the same ID meeting number and password for all of these meetings). If you need help in setting this up, please let Pastor Jennifer know and she'll help you walk through the basics of using Zoom. Zoom lets us "see" one another on our screens, as well as "hear" from one another too; there is also a call-in option using your phone, we won't be able to see you but we'll be able to hear you. You are always invited to join in these Zoom sessions as you are able.

Confirmation Sunday was scheduled for Sunday, May 24th and we are postponing this celebration for our current 8th grade students. We hope to reschedule for sometime this fall and will keep you updated.

Recognition of Graduates: Many graduations have either been postponed or cancelled due to Covid -19. People are being creative in how their recognizing graduates, with signs in yards, pictures/signs posted on school grounds, etc... Graduations are meant to be celebrations, of recognizing these important transitions and recognitions. If you would like to be a part of a recorded worship service by reading a scripture lesson or sharing prayers, please let Pastor Jennifer know. You don't need to come into the church to do this, you can record at home and e-mail it to her. Is there a favorite hymn you'd like to have included in a future worship recording or a prayer request you'd like included in worship? You can e-mail Pastor Jennifer with your suggestions and requests (if for a person, please make sure you have their permission to share publicly in the prayers).

An update about prayers in recorded worship: Pastor Jennifer has received some text messages, phone calls, and e-mails when a new name is added to the prayers in worship. Folks have offered concern and want to know about updates and/or reasons why people's names have been added. Since our recorded worship services are published and much more available to the public now, you've probably noticed that only the first names of people have been included in the prayers and the reasons why their names are mentioned have not been included. This is intentional, as a means of privacy and confidentiality for those mentioned. You can always feel free to contact Pastor Jennifer for specifics or updates, if she has the permission and information to share, she will.


